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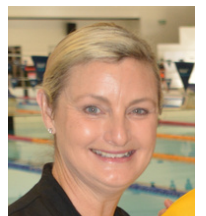

# COMMUNICATIONS FROM CITY OF MELVILLE - POOL REFURBISHMENT & RELOCATION

On Wednesday the 31st of May, a centre-wide communication was distributed by the City of Melville's LeisureFit team detailing the highly anticipated pool refurbishment plans and some tentative dates. Much of the detail in the update related to casual users of the facilities and centered around improvements to the leisure pool. Whilst still of interest and importance to members and the wider City of Melville community, we appreciate this did not address any of the concerns you may have for the relocation of South Shore Swimming Club going forward.

Please note that mention of the Riverton Leisureplex, Fremantle Leisure Centre and Bicton Pool are not being considered for relocation of South Shore Swimming Club. These facilities will merely be alternatives for leisure users. The South Shore Swimming Club Committee is in regular contact with the City of Melville LeisureFit management team and are working diligently to secure suitable facilities for the duration of our relocation, whilst minimising any impact of travel, access and the standard of facilities that you are used to.

While we encourage and welcome the transformation of LeisureFit Booragoon, there continue to be many undefinable milestones until the tenders are received and a decision made. In which case, we assure you that you will be informed with clear dates and a plan going forward well in advance.
